NOTES FROM THE PRESIDENT

At the time of writing this we are about to enter the Thanksgiving holiday. There is so much to be thankful for! I'm thankful for the freedom our veterans fought for in the past so we can worship our Lord and Savior. I'm thankful for the fellowship of our congregation. I'm thankful for the opportunity to serve the Lord.

We had our voter's meeting, and I want to thank everyone who was able to attend. I also want to thank the members who gave input and asked clarifying questions at the meeting. The voter's meeting is one of the forums for a candid and interactive conversation between the Council and the congregation. I'm also thankful for the Council members who put the effort into preparing and presenting for that meeting, and who do their best to make good decisions on behalf of the congregation every month as we meet. In the voter's meeting it was mentioned that the weekly giving is down, and the Council and Board of Finance attempted to reduce expenses for next year, but it will not be enough on its own to bring expenses in line with the current giving level. The Board of Finance and Council will be working to develop a giving campaign starting next year to ask the congregation to prayerfully consider increasing giving levels. To continue the long history of Bethany we will need to find additional funding. Please consider the e-giving option if you aren't using it now which allows regular giving to help with forecasting giving and managing cash flow for the church. We know the country's economic situation is not the best right now but pray for things to improve. We will also be working to organize outreach efforts to grow church membership.

I would like to mention a need for the Board of Education supporting Sunday School. Earlier this year we upgraded the Wi-Fi in the Fellowship Hall (Sunday School area). There is a need for a 42" Smart TV (Wi-Fi capable) and a DVD player plus cables. Today, short streaming videos which support the day's learning topic are played on a laptop computer or an iPad which are designed for individual use rather than a classroom. The children are used to much better technology in their classrooms, so I am asking the congregation to consider donating for Sunday School A/V (audio/ visual) to purchase equipment to enhance the Sunday School experience. This could also be used for movie nights in the Fellowship Hall which can assist in outreach efforts when friends of members are invited. You can designate giving to Sunday School A/V on your church envelope if this is a cause you would like to support.

In December, we begin the new church year celebrating Advent and the coming of our Lord. We also are looking forward to Pastor Steele returning on December 11th. On December 18th, there is a children's program planned, and we look forward to the Christmas Eve and Christmas Day services celebrating the birth of Jesus.
