#### **Promises Made Promises Kept**

Genesis 22:1ff "After these things God tested Abraham and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am."

He said, "Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him

there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you."

We are entering the political season. A famous phrase used by incumbents are "Promise Made Promise Kept!" However, the challenger begins to list all the promises made that weren't kept...Many who make promises are sincere in their desire to keep them. But, whether in government, business, or any other enterprise, almost all human beings have failed to deliver on promises at one time or another. There is plenty of blame for failing to keep promises—something unexpected happens, an unforeseen obstacle is encountered, a delivery is not made on time, there is an accident, the power fails, or other things happen that are out of our control, making it difficult or impossible to keep the promise we made.

From our text, we understand how one holds to the promise God establishes. We see in Abraham that He holds to God's promise. "...God tested Abraham and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." He said, "Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you." The promised one is to be sacrificed. First impression, God is going to break His promise.

God made a promise to Abraham while living in Haran. "Your name will be great, a great nation will come from you, and you will be a blessing for the entire world. (Gen. 12:1-3)" You need an heir. Mind you Abraham was 75 years of age and Sarah was 65 years of age. Physically and biologically, both were beyond their years...God is the "Promise Keeper."

It took 25 years for God's promise to be kept. Through those years Abraham and Sarah failed miserably in believing in that promise. Then when Abraham was 100 and Sarah 90, God fulfilled His promise in the birth of Isaac. Promises made...Promise kept. God never fails.

Now God's test...take your son your only son and sacrifice him in the region of Moriah. After a 3-day journey, Abraham sees his final destination. He orders the men with him to stay behind. Abraham makes this statement. "Stay here with the donkey; I and the boy will go over there and worship and come again to you." As Abraham and Isaac go on...Isaac speaks up: "My father!" And he said, "Here I am, my son." He said, "Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?" Abraham said, "God will provide for himself the lamb for a burnt offering, my son." So, they both went together. What does Abraham trust in?

In the very moment that Abraham raises his knife to strike...What does Abraham believe. God's promises will be fulfilled through Isaac. But he's going to kill Isaac...Again, what does Abraham believe...He believes in the "Promise Keeper". He believes this: "By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises was in the act of offering up his only son, of whom it was said, "Through Isaac shall your offspring be named." He considered that God was able even to raise him from the dead, from which, figuratively speaking, he did receive him back. (Hebrews 11:17-19)"

We are terrible "Promise Keepers." Marriages used to be the bedrock of our society. Now over 50% end in divorce. The marriage vow is our biggest promise that we make. Today many avoid marriage because of making and keeping that promise. We make many smaller, but important promises, and we break them. Promises are broken between siblings, friends, and co-workers. We are very unfaithful as "Promise Keepers". But God made a promise to every one of us. It is seen in the "Promise Kept" with Abraham.

Abraham's test is a foreshadowing of what our Heavenly Father does through Christ. During lent we relive again that God promised from the seed of the woman, Satan will be crushed. Yes, God's Son, His only Son, would be pierced by Satan's fangs, receive sins poison, die by crucifixion, and be buried in a garden's tomb. However, 3 days later, He would rise from the dead. Sin, eternal death, and Satan were destroyed at the cross and through the empty tomb. God's promise: "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him..." Our gracious God is a God of fulfillment. He's the perfect "Promise Keeper." Promises made...Promises Kept.

God makes a promise to all His baptized children. Yes, you've failed in keeping promises and other sins, but God's one and only Son, Jesus, has paid for all the broken promises. Throughout our lives we will continue to break promises. However, by God keeping His promise, we have a remedy. It is found in Jesus life, passion, death and Easter resurrection.


#### **HELP NEEDED!**
