#### **Reflections on Repentance – Lent Theme**

"From that time Jesus began to preach saying "Repent for the Kingdom of God is at hand." Matthew 4:2

"When the Lord Jesus called us to repent he meant that the whole life of the Christian would be one of repentance." These 1 from Luther's 95 Theses.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ.

Lent is a time of reflection and reevaluation of our lives. We can read that Irenaeus, who lived around 130 AD, talked about the fast before Easter that had been handed down by the forefathers to his present day. For him the forefathers would have been the Apostle's teaching as they set up the Church at the command of Jesus. They patterned the fast after Jesus' own 40 day fast and temptation in the desert before he started his ministry. When Jesus exited the temptation the first thing he said was "repent for the kingdom of God is at hand."

By the time of Gregory I (@ 600AD) the Church had established the pattern for fasting at one meal a day each day and no meat or dairy on Friday. The goal of all fasting is to help us realize how frail our bodies are that we may rely on God more. It is to help us understand that our ability to save ourselves is vanity and that we need God to save. It also helps us clear out our trust in the false idols in our lives, like food and money. Lastly it is to give us extra time to hear God's Word and pray.

As time has passed the strictness of Lenten fasting has eased. Now it is common to fast just one day and week but also give up something else for Lent. These days we might give up TV, or eating out, or social media with the goal of helping us reevaluate the time we spend with them.

We Lutherans still keep the Lenten time of preparation for Holy Week and Easter. We know we don't have to fast to earn forgiveness but we also recognize the goodness of devoting ourselves to God and His Word. We use Lent as a time to consider our lives in light of God's commands with the goal of repenting of where we have gotten too comfortable with sin. We have services and light meals and devotions that help us remember and reflect.

Our Lenten theme this year is "**Reflections on Repentance**." Each week we are going to see what sin truly is and how it is so damaging, especially when we take it so lightly. We will finish our journey by seeing how Jesus has won forgiveness for our sins by His sacrifice and rejoice in what He has done for us by bringing us into God's Kingdom.

That said, our trustees will soon be calling contractors to get estimates with hopes of them being able to do the work this summer. We will not be running a formal capital campaign, since this is a smaller scale project and may not cost more than \$10-12K; but do ask that you consider donating to the building improvement fund in the coming months to help cover the cost of this much needed project. 
